

# How to Pray According to Jesus (part 2)

Key Passage: Matthew 6:9-13

## Reflect

What did God's Word speak to your heart about today? What stood out to you in the message?  
Why do you believe prayer is important? What is something you learn from Romans 8:26-27?

## Review

- **Thy Kingdom Come (Matthew 6:10a)**
  - To pray for God's kingdom is to pray for His rule and reign to come.
    - Is God's kingdom going on in earth now? What do you learn from John 18:36?
    - When will God's kingdom come and Christ's reign be over all the earth (Read together: Revelation 19:11-16, 19-21, 20:1-7)
  - One day Christ's Kingdom will be set up, but until then His kingdom comes into the hearts of men.
    - Christ's kingdom comes into the hearts of unbelievers through salvation as they submit to Christ (Matthew 13:44-46). Why should pray then be evangelistic?
    - Christ's kingdom comes into the hearts of believers through their obedience. When you are praying for God's kingdom to come, what are you asking God to do in your life?
- **Thy Will be done (Matthew 6:10b)**
  - Why should you want the will of God done in your life?
  - When you pray do you pray for the purpose of asking God to do what you want, or are you seeking your will to be conformed to God's desires?
    - How was Jesus an example of seeking the Father's will?
  - Where should a believer go to find the will of God?
    - What do you learn from Psalm 40:7-8?
      - Psalm 40:7-8 — 7; *Then said I, Lo, I come: in the volume of the book it is written of me, 8; I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.*
    - What is God's will in the following verses:
