- V.37b

 - How has the generosity of others impacted your life?
 - Why does Jesus promote this kind of generosity?
- V.39-40
 - What people or influences (*i.e. messages from social media, movies, music, etc.*) in your life have led you down sinful or destructive paths?
 - What people or influences in your life have brought you closer to Jesus?
 - Who in this church would you like to spend more time with, because you know they will lead you closer to Jesus Christ?
 - What can you do today and this week to cut off the negative influences and cultivate the positive ones?
- V. 43-45
 - Have you seen evidence in your words and attitudes of bad fruit in your life this week? (*If you're brave, you may consider asking this to your spouse or another family member*)
 - What habits and disciplines would you like to cultivate that would begin storing up good spiritual fruit in your heart?
 - What can you do today and this week to cultivate one of those disciplines?
- V. 46-49
 - What is the primary spiritual & practical difference between the person who builds on the sandy foundation and the one who builds on the rock?
 - What can you do today in order to "do" the word of God?

1. Why did the Centurion send messengers to Jesus instead of going himself?
2. Put yourself in the Centurion's shoes, what would you have done if you heard Jesus was in town?
3. Which surprises you more, the Centurion's faith, or Jesus' miracle?
4. Why does Jesus marvel? What is so special about this Centurion's faith?
5. Read Hebrews 11:1. What is faith?
6. Read 2 Corinthians 4:6 and Romans 10:17. Where does faith come from?
7. Read Hebrews 11:6. Why do you think God is pleased by faith?
8. What can you learn from Jesus' miracle in this passage? How does it impact your thinking and your life?
